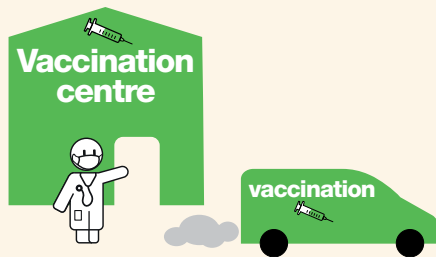

# How is the vaccination organized?



## Where to get vaccinated?

You can be vaccinated at a vaccination center or by a mobile team.

To ask for an appointment in a vaccination center near you:



- call **0 800 009 110** (toll-free)



- via the Internet: **www.sante.fr**



- for advice, ask a doctor, pharmacist or at the town hall.



## In practice

The vaccine is free.

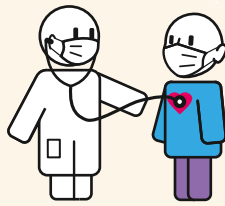


Keep the document with the name of the vaccine (to have 2 injections of the same vaccine).



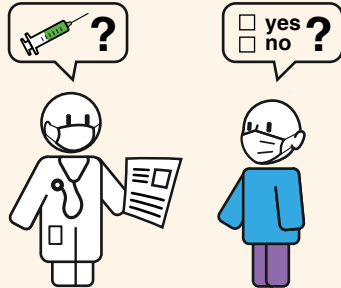
Take your "carte Vitale".

If you don't have one, you can still be vaccinated.

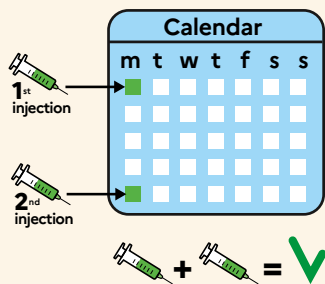


## Before vaccination

When you arrive, the healthcare professionals will check that the vaccine is recommended for you.

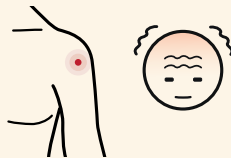


They will answer your questions. You will be asked if you agree to be vaccinated: you can choose to accept or refuse.



## The vaccine

To be protected, you need 2 injections a few weeks apart.



## After vaccinated

There are very few side effects from the vaccine. For 1 or 2 days, you may feel some pain in your arm, have a headache or some fever.
